



BUCHEGGER

Weingut Buchegger has deep roots. Three generations ago – in 1893 to be precise – the Buchegger family in Gedersdorf took up viticulture. In 1994, Walter Buchegger took over the business from his father Leopold and transformed it into a top quality wine estate, winning an international reputation in the process. In 2006 he moved the headquarters of the estate to the village of Dross. Since Walter's death in June 2018, his life-partner Silke Mayr has been managing the estate. The vines themselves remain rooted in the vineyards of Gedersdorf, and all parcels cultivated by the estate are located in the state of Niederösterreich's winegrowing regions Kremstal & Kamptal.

The area under vines currently covers around eleven hectares, with production being mainly based in the varieties Grüner Veltliner, Riesling, Roter Veltliner, Chardonnay & Blauer Zweigelt.

The estate's top sites are the Gedersdorf vineyards Moosburgerin, Vordernberg and Tiefenthal, which comprise some 70% of its total vineyard area.

In the estate's extraordinarily & beautifully maintained vineyards – mostly planted in soils of loess or weathered conglomerates – the greatest attention is paid to near-to-nature management and stringent limitations to yield. Particular attention is paid to the care of old vine cultures, which have been spared from any clonal breeding that would send things in the wrong direction.

Depending on their individual characteristics, the wines are fermented and matured in wooden casks or stainless steel tanks. Our vinifications seek to yield wines that are as faithful as possible to the variety & the vineyard. Terroir and origin are of the utmost importance, and maintaining a humus-rich soil always remains the Golden Rule.

The grape material – and later the wine – is only treated as little as possible and then with extreme care, in order to bring the precise quality and character of the grapes from the vineyard into the bottle. From the lighter wines up to the reserves, our portfolio is focused upon achieving conspicuous elegance and wholesome character.

Numerous awards at many domestic and international competitions – as well as excellent reviews in the national trade press – confirm the estate's successful efforts to achieve the greatest quality. The high degree of ripeness in the wines guarantees drinking pleasure for many years, which our visitors and clients have come to appreciate and cherish.
